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Notes to Editors

- Kawasaki Disease Kawasaki Disease is the leading cause of acquired heart disease in children in the UK. Children affected by Kawasaki Disease have much improved chances of a good recovery with timely diagnosis and the correct treatment. Kawasaki Disease is a type of vasculitis. It mainly affects young children but it can affect people of any age and its impact can be most serious in the very young, particularly infants. It is a serious illness as it can cause coronary artery damage damage to the blood vessels in the heart, and can lead to acquired heart disease in children. Kawasaki Disease has a range of symptoms including a characteristic and distinctively persistent high fever for five days or more, rash, bloodshot eyes, "strawberry" tongue, cracked, dry lips, redness of the fingers and toes and swollen glands in the neck. Kawasaki Disease can be present with some or all of these symptoms and symptoms often appear in series (i.e. not all at once). Kawasaki Disease should always be considered in any child with unexplained persistent fever.
